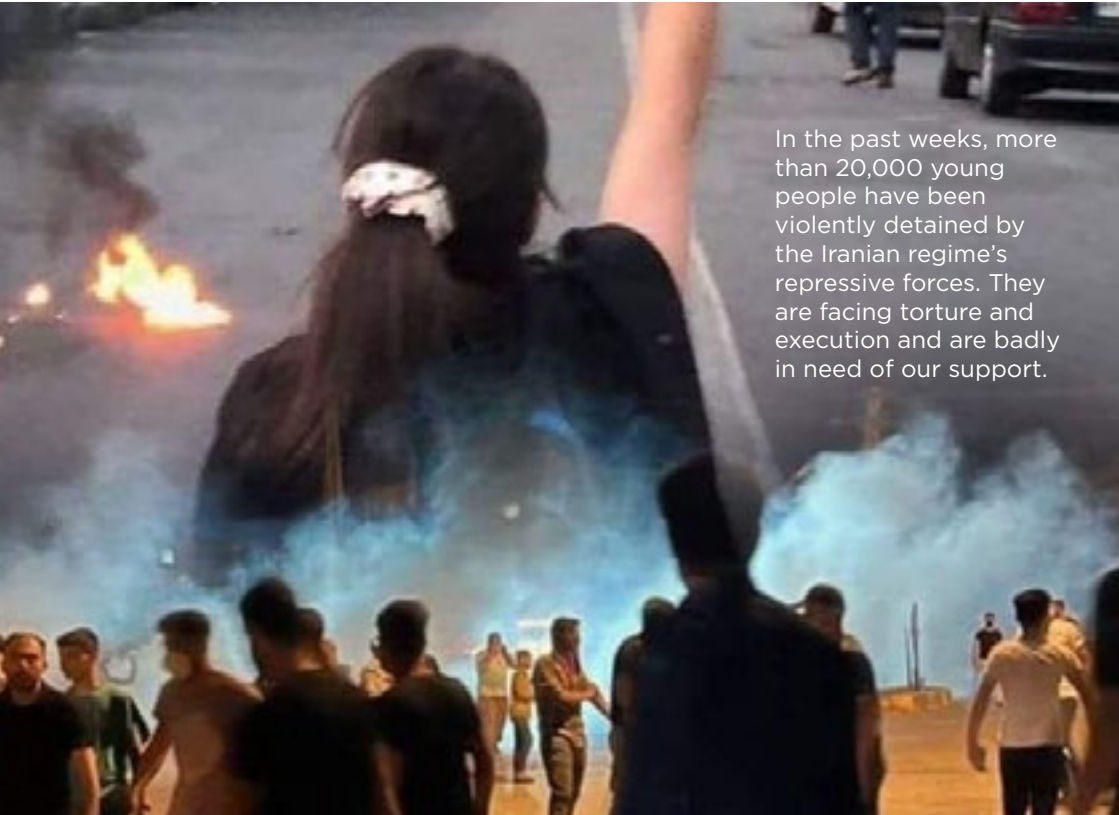

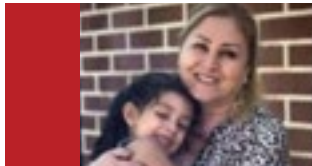

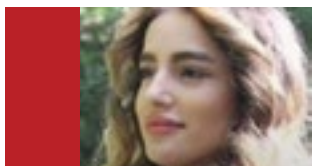
MORE THAN **400**

SOME OF THE BRUTAL TRAGEDIES NOW ROUTINELY TAKING PLACE IN IRAN:



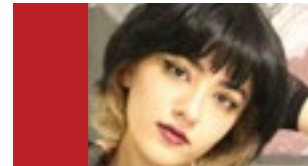
Mino Majidi is pictured here with her daughter. Her dreams of freedom are now inherited by her daughter, even though she no longer can enjoy the hugs, kisses and love of her late mother. Mino was killed by the suppressive forces in the Kurdish city of Kermanshah on September 20th.



Hadis Najafi, 23 years-old, dubbed 'the ponytail girl', outspoken, valiant and full of life, did not give in to the harassment of the paramilitary Basij. She was subsequently gunned down by six bullets while protesting for her right to live and make her own choice of dress.



Zakaria Khial, a 16-year-old teenager from Piranshahr was shot dead by the Iranian regime's suppressive forces while he was peacefully protesting against widespread suppression.



Nika Shahkarami, a 17-year-old girl, was arrested by security forces. Her family looked for her for 11 days, and eventually a day before her birthday her dead body was handed over to her family by the regime.

Nilofar Hamedei was the first Iranian journalist who alerted the world about the death of Mahsa Amini and was arrested for her noble deed. Her bravery has inspired women of all walks of life.



Elahe Mohamadi, a journalist, was arrested for reporting the funeral ceremony of Mahsa Amini.



Bayan Azizi, poet and women's rights activist, who has a PhD in international studies, was detained for offering a new, inspiring role for women in the Kurdish city of Sanandaj, North-west of Iran.



Mona Borzouei, a 38-year-old renowned poet, singer and songwriter. She was arrested on 28 September after she posted a video of her latest poem in which she voiced her support for the young men & women protesting for a free Iran.
